The New Era in Corneal Transplantation

CORNEAL TRANSPLANTATION is now more than 100 years old with the first corneal transplant being done by Eduard Zirm in 1905. Since that first successful corneal transplant, innumerable ophthalmologists have contributed to the development and refinement of corneal transplantation aided by the development of surgical microscopes, refined suture materials, the development of eye banks and introduction of corticosteroids.

This was a full thickness transplant done with all layers of the donor being put in-toto after removal of a corresponding portion of the recipient and then sutured in place by nylon sutures, the sutures then being removed in about a year. This type of keratoplasty has stood the test of time and still works today. This type is known as Optical keratoplasty (OPK). The same procedure done in an emergency for infection removal or tectonic purposes such as sealing of a corneal perforation is known as therapeutic keratoplasty (TPK). This has helped save many infected eyes and later a new life could be infused in them.

The new era dawned with the arrival of newer transplants which are lamellar. These keratoplasties entail replacement of only the diseased parts of the cornea making them last longer by making them more acceptable to the host by reducing the risk of corneal graft rejection. Graft rejection means the host immune system recognized the host immune response is directed toward antigens in the donor corneal button.

The first type of lamellar transplant is Deep Anterior Lamellar Keratoplasty (DALK). Here the anterior four layers of the cornea are replaced by the donor either to correct an abnormal shape (e.g., keratoconus) or a scar confined to the anterior layers.

The other type of transplant entails replacement of the diseased endothelium by a healthy donor. This would be encountered after a difficult cataract surgery leading to a pseudophakic bullous keratopathy (PBK) or a genetic condition like Fuchs endothelial dystrophy which leads to a gradual decompensation of the corneal endothelium. Herein two subtypes of transplant are possible. The first and the older type is the Descemet stripping Endothelial Keratoplasty (DSEK) where a thin layer of posterior stroma is implanted with the Descemet's membrane. The second type is more physiologic and a bit more challenging surgically is the Descemet membrane Endothelial keratoplasty (DMEK) where only the host Descemet membrane is implanted and apposed to the bare stroma of the recipient (after removal of the dysfunctional donor Descemet membrane). This type of transplant also does not need any sutures and is secured in place by an air bubble.

The era of lamellar corneal transplants has also ushered in the use of a single cornea to two recipients thus helping cut down the crisis we face due to shortage of donor tissue.

Further developments continue to occur such as artificial corneas, 3D printed cornea and liquid cornea which are in trial stages.

To summarize we had an explosive development in the field of corneal transplantation evolving from the age-old full thickness keratoplasty to replacement to a layer as thin as just 5 to 10 microns. The field remains exciting and ever-evolving thanks to all the scientists and clinicians all over the world.

Final Rules for the Cricket Tournament

1. All players participating in tournament need to be **LIFE member of IMA, Vadodara** at the time of the match. If it is found that, a player is not the member of IMA, Vadodara then that match will be cancelled and winning points will be awarded to the opponent team. Preference should be given to the players of own specialty. Under graduate and Intern will not be allowed to play. A team can take maximum 2 players who are the **LIFE time member** (Certificate must be submitted in physical copy) of any branch other than IMA, Vadodara, with associate membership of IMA, Vadodara branch with Rs. 1500/- for one year i.e. from January to December. Each captain has responsibility to collect the associate player's life time membership certificate and associate membership receipt and submitted to IMA, Vadodara branch before 15 days of the tournament.
2. Registration fees for IMA Inter Specialty Cricket tournament - 2024 is Rs. 20,000/-.
3. A player will be allowed to play for any one team during whole tournament.
4. We will appoint two Umpires and a Scorer during all matches – Their decision will be final in case of disputes on the ground.
5. League matches, Semifinals and Final will be of 12 overs. Final decision will be taken as per number of entries will receive.
6. A bowler can bowl maximum of 3 overs in 12 overs.
7. Power Play Overs - will be of 3 in 12 overs. First two over of the match will be PP overs, during which fielding team can keep maximum 2 players in outer circle. One more PP over can be taken by batting team during any time before last over after informing umpire one over before, during which fielding team can keep maximum 3 players in outer circle.
8. At any time fielding team can keep maximum 5 players on Leg side.
9. In tournament Bye, Leg bye and Overthrow will be allowed. But LBW will not be considered.
10. Umpire can declare No ball in case of underarm or throw bowling without any intimation to the bowler.
11. Free hit will be given for each No ball in which only hit wicket or run out will be considered out.
12. Reporting time for each match will be 30 minutes before the scheduled start of play for that match and walkover will be given after waiting of 15 minutes over the scheduled starting time.
13. Each team has to declare its 15 - 20 players list at least 7 days before tournament. Each team has to submit list of playing team (12 members) before toss. Changing in that will not be allowed than after during whole match. In case of injury fielding replacement will be allowed from the list of members given by the team.
14. Winners of each group match will get 2 Points.
15. Super over will be played to decide winner in case of tie.
16. There will be only 10 minutes break between two innings. No unnecessary delayed will be allowed.
17. Match will be played with KHANNA GLOREX tennis ball. New ball will be provided during each inning and in case of lost or damage.
18. In case of tie for 1st and 2nd positions in each group, runs per over (average) will be counted. If the tie still persists, then wickets will be considered.
19. 1st positioned team of a group will play with 2nd positioned team of opposite group in semifinals.
20. Final decision regarding any dispute will be with the referee for that day.
21. In unavoidable circumstances IMA has power to reschedule or cancel the dates of tournament.

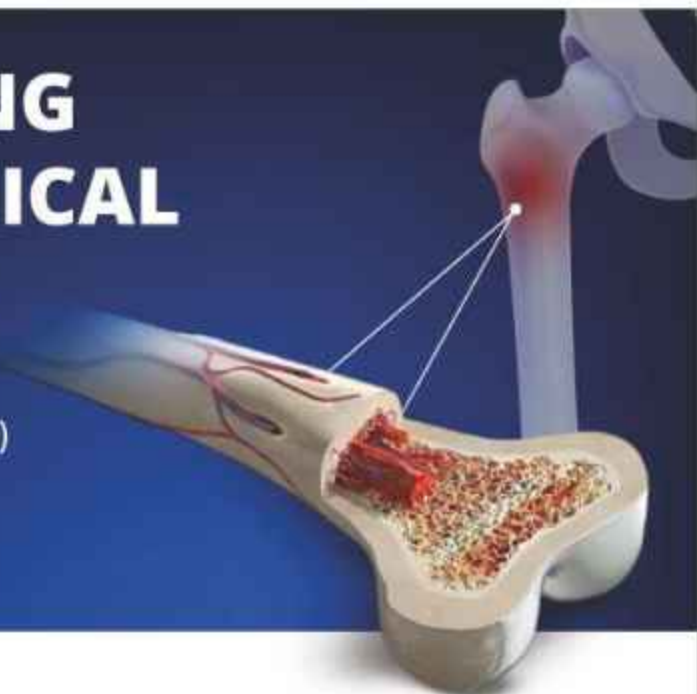

NAFLD

Non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD), whose prevalence is on the rise, is strongly linked to type 2 diabetes (T2D), through insulin resistance and oxidative stress.

A multi-factorial association with type 1 diabetes (T1D) has recently been found. NAFLD screening aims at identifying more severe forms, non-alcoholic steatohepatitis (NASH with fibrosis) and correctly referring the patient to liver specialists.

It is recommended for patients at a higher risk, such as those with T2D.

The cornerstone for NAFLD treatment is weight loss, dietary measures, obesity pharmacotherapy or bariatric surgery.

For patients with NAFLD and T2D, GLP-1 analogues and PPAR agonists should be considered, which are capable of regressing NASH, and SGLT2 inhibitors, which are efficient for simple steatosis.

CONCLUSION:

Faced with such an epidemiological increase in NAFLD, physicians in charge of type 2 diabetic patients must pay particular attention to this metabolic complication. A screening including an FIB-4 score and, possibly, an elastography or an ELF test, is recommended in order to be able to refer the patient to a hepatologist, if required. It is necessary to focus on different ways to obtain a weight loss of at least 5 to 10% and to optimize glycemic control. For drug selection, GLP-1 analogs, PPAR agonists and SGLT-2 inhibitors are preferred. In case of cirrhosis, an individualized and multidisciplinary approach is recommended.

PRACTICAL IMPLICATION:

Screening

It is recommended that screening be carried out for advanced forms of non-alcoholic steatopathy (NAFLD) patients who are prediabetic, have type 2 diabetes, for

patients who are obese and/or suffering from metabolic syndrome, patients diagnosed with steatosis by imaging techniques and patients presenting for 6 months with elevated serum levels of transaminases.

The screening is carried out by FIB-4 score and, possibly, an elastography and/or a serum ELF test.

Management

Weight loss and glycemic balance are to be sought when treating patients with NAFLD and 2 diabetes. On a medication plan, GLP-1 analogues, PPAR agonists and SGLT2 inhibitors are to be preferred.

SYSTEMIC SCLEROSIS

Systemic sclerosis (SSc) is a rare autoimmune disease principally affecting women between 40 and 60 years old. It is characterized by a cutaneous and visceral fibrosis, an alteration of the microvascular network and the presence of autoantibodies. SSc can be associated with another. This interrelation between associated diseases and systemic sclerosis sometime changes the progression of systemic sclerosis and increases the need of a personalized follow-up. her connective tissue disease or to other autoimmune diseases thus defining the overlap syndrome. CEREBRAL SMALL VESSEL DISEASE SUMMARY

Cerebral microangiopathy is the second leading cause of dementia after Alzheimer's disease and is a co-factor in the majority of dementias. Its clinical manifestations are

multiple and also in addition to cognitive and neuropsychiatric manifestations, problem of gait, urinary incontinence, and lacunar-ischemic and hemorrhagic strokes. Patients with similar radiologic images can present very variable clinical pictures, partially resulting from damage to the neurovascular unit, not visible on conventional MRI, and affecting different neural networks. Management and prevention are possible and effective with well-known, readily available and affordable treatments, through aggressive management of cerebrovascular risk factors.

CONCLUSION:

CM is a major cause of dementia and is a cofactor in the majority of dementias. It is the result of alteration of the neurovascular unit initiated by the presence of CVRF. Their early and intensive treatment, therefore makes it possible to reduce the occurrence or progression of dementia, with well-known treatments available on the market at relatively low cost.
